

Ports of Philadelphia Maritime Society 2023 Scholarship Program

Founded in 1935, the Ports of Philadelphia Maritime Society has been awarding scholarships to Pennsylvania, Delaware, and New Jersey Residents or employees seeking education and advancement in the local Maritime Industry since 2012.

A maximum of **six scholarships** (6) have been approved for 2023, for up to **\$2,500** each. Scholarship funds will be applied directly to the institution specified for tuition purposes. Tuition already paid to a post high school education, or a professional training institution can be reimbursed within twelve (12) months after the date it was paid.

THERE ARE **THREE CATEGORIES** of scholarships. Scholarship funds will be directly applied as indicated.

- 1. **INDUSTRY DEGREE** (CURRENT OR FUTURE COLLEGE/ACADEMY STUDENT) Tuition for Post High School Student in Degree Program in a Higher Education Marine, Maritime, Engineering, Naval Architecture, Transportation or Logistics.
- 2. **MARINER ADVANCEMENT** Tuition towards USCG required training for an original credential, license, or upgrade (not a renewal)
- 3. **PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT** Tuition towards attendance to a Certificated Professional Development Course related to Marine, Maritime or Port-Related Subject and or employment.
